Q & A

WOMEN SHOULD BUILD DEEP TECHNICAL CONFIDENCE

HANDINI BALASUBRAMANIAN
DIRECTOR, TESCOCOM
CORE TEAM MEMBER, ELCIA - COE SENSORS



Q Could you walk us through your academic background and what led you to this field?

A: I started my college education in Arts and I loved being in that stream. After that I started working with a public Sector organization. But my quest for entrepreneurship was always brimming inside. So, I took up to food business which was my passion too. After successful execution of the food business, I moved to Electronics Manufacturing. One of my neighbours, Mr. Balasubramanian was highly successful in running his own Electronics Business. I always used to feel fascinated by the way he took challenges in business so easily. I put forth my request to join him. He too had identified the need the enthusiasm and took me into his business. I was a silent and ardent follower understanding the nuances of this business. The training and experience I gained by travelling along with a successful leader made me become more confident and this is where I am today. After entering into business of Electronics, I took a break and completed a full time MBA when I was 44 years old. This exposure to Management Education made me more perfect. Currently I am pursuing my doctorate in Emerging Technology which is the need of the hour.

Q We'd love to know more about your career path leading up to your current position at Tescom.

A: My career path has been a bit of struggle. Starting one's own venture is different from taking over a legacy and managing it. I joined already successful business which was run by my mentor. But I still had some new ideas and new areas of focus which I had to implement. This was a bit of challenge. But Mr. Balu is a very seasoned entrepreneur and his risk taking abilities are very high. He gave me the freedom to experiment after he understood the potential in me. Not looking at the result and only looking at the successful implementation had led to me this position today.

Q Can you give our readers an overview of your company, Tescom, and its key offerings?

A: TESCOCOM is an Electronic Manufacturing service offering contract manufacturing jobs to various sectors like Automotive, Medical, Defense, Aerospace, Telematics and other IoT products. We have state of the art equipments and the best-in-class machinery which are fully automated from end to end.

WOMEN IN ELECTRONICS

Q & A

Q What role do organizations like EL-ECIA (Electronics City Industries Association) play in strengthening and advancing the MSME sector in India? How important are such industry bodies in driving collaboration, innovation, and policy advocacy?

A: Industry associations such as the Electronics City Industries Association (ELCIA) play a pivotal role in nurturing the growth and competitiveness of India's MSME sector. By acting as a bridge between individual enterprises, government bodies and other stakeholders, they deliver value across three core dimensions: collaboration, innovation, and policy makers.

1. Policy Advocacy & Representation

Unified Voice to Government MSMEs are often too small individually to influence policy. Associations aggregate the needs of hundreds of member units and present coherent, data-backed recommendations to central and state governments (e.g., on taxation, regulatory simplification, credit access).

Regulatory Navigation They interpret and guide members through complex regulations (GST, labour laws, environmental norms) for members, organize workshops and issue with regulators to minimize compliance burdens.

Access to Incentive Schemes By informing and guiding members on schemes such as Credit Linked Capital Subsidy, Technology Upgradation Fund, and export incentives, they ensure that MSMEs can avail benefits effectively.

2. Cluster Development & Shared Infrastructure

Common Facility Centres (CFCs) ELCIA Cluster, for instance, manages shared prototyping labs, testing facilities and calibration centers. This lowers capital expenditure for individual units and accelerates time-to-market.

Logistics & Bulk Procurement Collective procurement of raw materials or bulk logistics contracts reduces economies of scale, better pricing, and payment terms for members.

Quality & Standards By setting up in-house quality labs and certification drives, associations help MSMEs meet global standards (ISO, RoHS, CE), enhancing export readiness.

Q In high-level positions, disagreements are inevitable. What's your strategy for resolving these effectively?

A: Disagreements are not only inevitable, but often necessary for innovation and growth decision making. I always believe in first understanding and then getting understood. Also, I believe in listening with intent, not just to respond. Zero Ego is also the key to success.

Q As a woman in a somewhat male-dominated industry, have you faced any obstacles or biases?

A: I would not say that I faced obstacles, but I had clearly seen in the early stages of my career, the industry was not inclusive to my thoughts and ideas. These were the days when the industry was underrepresented by women at Senior levels.

Q How can young women in electronics navigate their careers more confidently and effectively, in your view? What would be your one piece of advice?

A: First piece of advice is that women should build deep technical confidence. Women should not getting involved in real projects right from their university days. Also, women should learn to negotiate effectively and keep reaching forward.

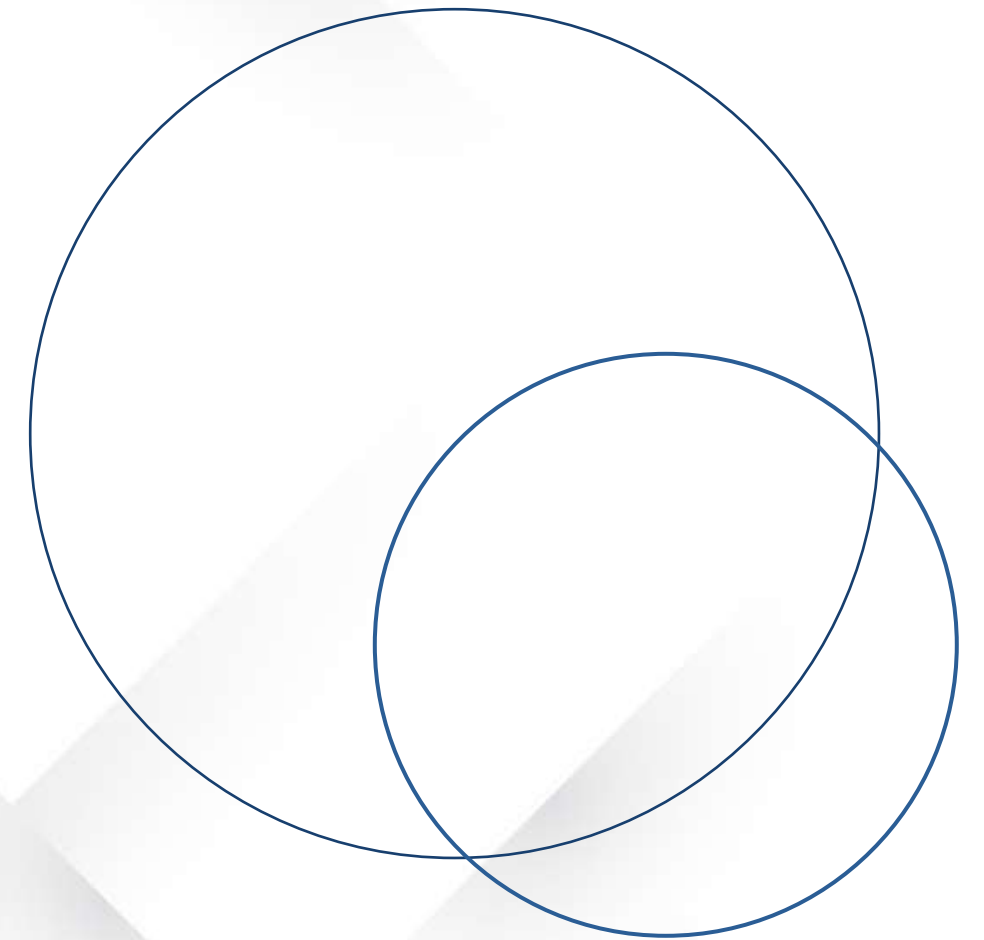
